Well done to the many lifeguards who have been busy training and increasing their skills over the winter months on various courses and workshops in order to be ready for summer patrols.

IRB

Welcome to new member Justin Martin who has brought his vast knowledge of IRB boats and motors and a history of racing and outfitting Surf Rescue boats with him. Justin will be working with our racing teams and assisting Skip Fisher in looking after the IRBs this summer. First Aid Courses - 2010

SLSNZ and PSLSC are again subsidising some specific first aid courses to ensure lifeguards remain current with their qualifications. First Aid certification remains current for two years. You must sit a refresher within this time or consequently complete the full two-day course again if it lapses (there is a three month leeway if you are just outside the two years). Prices are subsidised by 50% for club members by both PSLSC and SLSNZ. All registrations must come through PSLSC office – info@papamoalifeguards.co.nz. Well done to everyone that has refreshed or up-skilled already over this past winter.

2010 – 2011 Surf Sports Levy

At this time there has been no increase in the Surf Sports Levy and it will remain \$150 per person. *This fee is to be paid by every club member participating and competing in any of the optional surf sports competition programmes the club offers i.e. beginners to advanced beach and surf sports: ski, board, canoe and surf boat. **It does not apply to Junior Surf members only participating on Sunday mornings.** The surf sports levy covers entry fees to specified SLSNZ events, the use of club equipment and a structured coaching programme. More detail is listed in the Surf Sports section. This SSL must be paid by 31 October 2010 and no event may be entered until this has been paid.*

Finally, just a reminder about a couple of things that always seems to cause confusion at this time of the year. Firstly, each child's age group is determined by their age on the 30th September - if they're not 5 by this date, we can't register them until next season. Secondly, it's a requirement that **all** 200m & 400m badges are reassessed each year - this can be done at the Junior Surf session that'll be organised for the end of November, by a Surf Sports Coach or by a Director of the club.

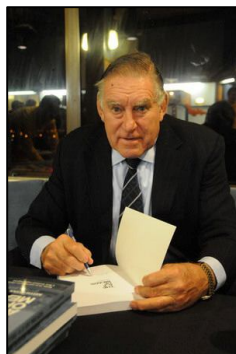

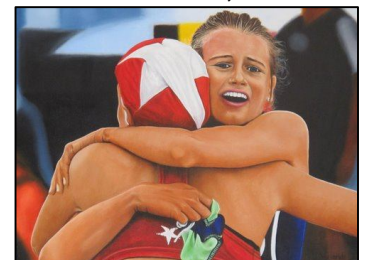
